PCSD Resolution No. 02-199

***A RESOLUTION IMPOSING FINES AND PENALTIES AND
CREATING A TRUST FUND THEREFOR FOR THE USE OF THE
PALAWAN COUNCIL FOR SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT (PCSD)***

WHEREAS, the PCSD requires that all projects or undertakings in the province of Palawan should secure SEP clearance from the PCSD prior to implementation and for violation of this requirement the PCSD imposes a fine in the amount of Fifty Thousand Pesos (P50,000.00);

WHEREAS, the imposition of such fine was waived during the incumbency of the previous PCSD Chair;

WHEREAS, it has been observed that some proponents apply for SEP clearance when the establishment is already operational leaving the Council no choice but to approve the application;

WHEREFORE, upon motion of Gov. Joel T. Reyes, duly seconded by Atty. Joselito Alisuag, the Council resolves, as it hereby resolved, to impose fines and penalties to proponents who violate the PCSD rules and regulations;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that a trust fund shall be created where collections from such fines and penalties shall be deposited for the use of the PCSD;

RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that applications about to be approved in this meeting shall not be covered by this resolution;


RESOLVED FINALLY, that copies of this resolution be furnished the concerned agencies for their guidance and appropriate action.
