**“REITERATING RESOLUTION NO. 15-525, INCREASING
THE ALLOWANCES OF THE MEMBERS OF THE
PALAWAN COUNCIL FOR SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT
TO PHP10,000.00 FOR YEAR 2019 AND ONWARDS”**

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7611, otherwise known as the Strategic Environmental Plan (SEP) for Palawan, took effect on 19 June 1992 section 6 of which provides that the SEP shall serve as the framework to guide the government agencies concerned in the formulation of plans, programs and projects affecting the environment and natural resources of Palawan;

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the same law provides that the governance, implementation and policy direction of the SEP shall be exercised by the Palawan Council for Sustainable Development (PCSD), the composition of which is likewise provided therein;

Mission: PCSDS as the driver of environmental conservation and inclusive development in Palawan, a biosphere reserve and science-for-sustainability site, guided by the Strategic Environmental Plan


WHEREAS, the Council in 2015 passed Resolution No. 15-525, increasing the allowance of members to “Five Thousand Pesos (Php5,000.00) in 2015 and Php10,000 in 2016 and onwards, however, due to budget limitation the increase of Php5,000 was implemented only in 2018, instead of 2015 and the increase to Php10,000 to start in 2019;

WHEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing premises and on motion duly seconded, the Council **RESOLVES**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED** reiterating the increase of allowances for the Council members from Php5,000.00 to Php10,000.00 for the years 2019 and onwards;


RESOLVED, FURTHER, that copy of this resolution be furnished the PCSDS Finance and Admin Division for their information and guidance;
