**PCSD Resolution No. 99-135**

***RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CY 1999 WORK AND  
FINANCIAL PLAN OF THE PALAWAN COUNCIL FOR  
SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT STAFF***

**WHEREAS**, under Section 20 of Republic Act 7611 otherwise known as the Strategic Environmental Plan (SEP) for Palawan Act, the Palawan Council for Sustainable Development Staff (PCSDS) shall serve as the regular professional staff of the Palawan Council for Sustainable Development (PCSD) and shall provide the machinery to coordinate the policy and functions, implement programs and organize such services as may be required by the Council in the exercise of its functions;

WHEREAS, to pursue the goals and objectives of the Strategic Environmental Plan of Palawan, the Palawan Tropical Forestry Protection Programme was identified as a special project of the Palawan Council for Sustainable Development Staff;

WHEREAS, as per the General Appropriations Act of 1999, the Palawan Council for Sustainable Development Staff was appropriated the amount of P 33.087 million to cover its CY 1999 regular operations and the sum of P 11.867 million to implement the Palawan Tropical Forestry Protection Programme;

WHEREAS, to meet the operational requirements of the Palawan Council for Sustainable Development Staff and to ensure that the SEP goal is achieved, a work and financial plan including its staffing pattern is hereto attached as Annex "A";

NOW THEREFORE, upon the motion of Dir. Alisuag, unanimously seconded by the members present, the Palawan Council for Sustainable Development:


RESOLVED, as it is hereby RESOLVED, to approve, as it is hereby approved, the 1999 PCSDS Work and Financial Plan, including the staffing pattern.
