PCSD RESOLUTION NO. 94-61

RESOLUTION ENDORSING THE PROPOSED AIR GUNNERY AND BOMBING RANGE WITHIN THE INAGAWAN SUB-COLONY, PUERTO PRINCESA CITY

WHEREAS, R.A. 7611, otherwise known as the Strategic Environmental Plan (SEP) for Palawan, took effect on 19 June 1992 and Section 16 of said Act provides that the governance, implementation and policy direction of the SEP shall be exercised by the Palawan Council for Sustainable Development (PCSD), under the Office of the President;

WHEREAS, the Western Command of the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) through its Commanding General, Maj. Gen. Carlos F. Tanega, proposed the establishment of a Gunnery and Bombing Range at the Inagawan Sub-Colony, Puerto Princesa City;

WHEREAS, Section 22 of the "Rules and Regulations Implementing the Strategic Environmental Plan for Palawan Act", adopted by the Council on 04 September 1992, provides that the term of office of members other than those mentioned in Section 16 of R.A. 7611 shall be for a period of one year from the date of assumption of office;

WHEREAS, PCSD Resolution No. 93-31, adopted on 24 September 1994, specified the term of office of the non-regular members of the Council from 1993 to 1994;

WHEREAS, the members of the Council recognized the need to extend the term of office of its non-regular members;

NOW THEREFORE, upon motion by Exec. Dir. Arthur R. Ventura duly seconded by all the members of the Council present, the Council hereby;


RESOLVED, as it hereby resolve, that the term of office of the non-regular members of Council are extended and/or specified as follows:

6. Rev. Fr. Armand Limsa, until 20 November 1995


RESOLVED FINALLY, that copies of this resolution be sent to all local government units and concerned agencies for their information, consideration and appropriate action;
