ECSD RESOLUTION NO. 95-70

APURAVAN-APPROVING AND ENDORSING THE RESOLUTION KULANDANUM-BERONG-ARAMAYWAN (AKBA) ECOLOGICAL/ECONOMIC ZONAL MODELLING PROJECT PROPOSED BY THE PROVINCIAL ENRO OF THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT OF PALAVAN

WHEREAS, R.A. 7611, otherwise known as the Strategic Environmental Plan (SEP) for Falawan, took effect on 19 June 1992 and Section 6 of said Act provides that the SEF shall serve as the framework to guide the government agencies concerned in the formulation of plans, programs and projects affecting environment and natural resources of Palawan;

7611 provides that the WHEREAS, Section 16 of R.A. governance, implementation and policy direction of the SEP shall be exercised by the Falawan Council for Sustainable Development (PCSD), under the Office of the President;

WHEREAS. Sections 7-11 of said Act provides for the establishment of an Environmentally Critical Areas Network (ECAN), the main strategy of SEP which is a graded system of protection and development control over the whole of Falawan, including its tribal lands, forests, mines, agricultural areas, settlement areas, small islands, mangroves, coral reefs, seagrass beds and the surrounding sea;

WHEREAS, the FCSD, in its 23rd Council meeting held on 18 February 1994, adopted the guidelines in implementing the ECAN, prescribing among others, the allowable activities within the identified zones;

WHEREAS, the Frovincial Government through its Provincial Environment and Natural Resources Office (ENRO) in its desire to contribute in the operationalization and management at the local level of the SEF and the ECAN through localized determination in resource-based development, formulated and proposed the Apurawan-Kulandanum-Berong-Aramaywan (AKBA) Eco/Economic Zonal Modelling Project, located within the municipalities of Aborlan and Quezon, Palawan;

WHEREAS, the Proposed Project has, among others, the following components: biodiversity conservation network planning, buffer zone rehabilitation/enhancement, terrestrial/coastal resource management, and an ASEAN Center for eco/economic studies:

WHEREAS, the FCSD, in recognition of the potential of:

(a) the Provincial ENRO as an institutional tool within Palawan that could assist the Council in attaining the sustainable development goals and objectives of the SEP as specified by R.A. 7611, (b) the area abovecited known as AKBA, and (c) replicating the said Project in other areas of the Province:

NOW THEREFORE, upon motion by Atty. Teodoro Q. Pena, duly seconded by all the members of the Council present, the Council:

RESOLVED, as it hereby resolve, that the proposed AKBA Eco/Economic Zonal Modelling Project proposed by the Provincial ENRO is approved and endorsed by the Council;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the Council direct, as it hereby directs:

- A. The Provincial ENRO to:
- Immmediately implement the said Project and coordinate, where applicable, with the FCSD Staff and other concerned agencies, within the framework of the SEF.

- Z. Identify and acquire additional source of funds for the Project from government and private institutions, both locally and internationally,
- Ensure the: (a) active participation of the local government units and local population in the said Project, and (b) inclusion of security of land tenure of the indigenous cultural communities (ICCs) the Project area.
- 4. To periodically report to the Council, the status the said Froject.
- The FCSD Staff and concerned agencies to: В.
- Assist the Provincial ENRO, where required. the implementation of the said Project.
- Provide funds, if possible, under existing government 2. rules and regulations, to the said Project.
