PCSD Resolution No. 99-146D

***RESOLUTION IMPOSING PROCESSING FEES ON
APPLICATIONS FOR SEP CLEARANCE OF
PROJECTS AND UNDERTAKINGS IN PALAWAN.***

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7611 adopted the Strategic Environmental Plan (SEP) as the comprehension framework for sustainable development of the province and created the PCSD as the administrative machinery for the governance, implementation and policy direction of the SEP;

WHEREAS, Sections 7 to 11 provides the establishment of ECAN, a graded system of protection and development control over the whole province involving the designation of management zones and their prescribed uses;

WHEREAS, in order to ensure that projects and undertaking in Palawan conform with the ECAN guidelines setforth in PCSD Resolutions No. 94-44, 99-144, and 99-147, the PCSD requires that all projects and undertaking in Palawan should secure SEP clearance prior to implementation and for all permitting agencies concerned to require SEP clearance prior to the issuance of permits or licenses in the utilization of natural resources;

WHEREAS, based on the administrative cost incurred in the evaluation of applications for SEP clearance there is a need to impose the payment of processing fees to be paid to PCSDS by proponents upon submission of the required documents enumerated in PCSD Resolution No. 99-146;

WHEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Vicente A. Sandoval, duly seconded, the Council resolves, as it is hereby **RESOLVED** to impose processing fees on applications for SEP clearance of projects and undertakings in Palawan.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the amounts to be imposed shall be as follows:
