PCSD RESOLUTION NO. 13-448

“RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ISSUANCE OF SEP CLEARANCE/PCSD ACCREDITATION FOR THE FIFTEEN (15) PROJECTS DULY EVALUATED AND SUBMITTED BY THE PCSD STAFF FOR COUNCIL’S ACTION DURING ITS 194th REGULAR MEETING”

WHEREAS, R.A. 7611 otherwise known as the Strategic Environmental Plan (SEP) for Palawan Act was signed into law on June 19, 1992 by then President Corazon C. Aquino;

WHEREAS, Section 16 of said Act provides that the governance, implementation and policy direction of the SEP shall be exercised by the Palawan Council for Sustainable Development, hereinafter referred to as the Council;

“PCSDS: Working together towards sustaining the future.”

WHEREAS, Section 19 (10) of Same Act empowers the Council to perform related functions which shall promote the development, conservation, management and utilization of the natural resources of Palawan;

WHEREAS, the Council approved Administrative Order No. 6 series of 2008 that serves as guide for all government instrumentalities mandated to issue permits, licenses, contracts, or agreements and other similar instrumentalities; as amended, the guidelines in the implementation of the Strategic Environmental Plan to all projects and undertakings being or intended to be implemented in Palawan;

WHEREAS, the Council likewise approved Administrative Order No. 5, Series of 2000, as amended by PCSD Resolutions No. 03-209 and 03-211 adopted on April 24, 2003 and July 24, 2003, respectively, that serves as guide for Accreditation, Regulation and Monitoring of Live Fish Catching, Culture, Transport and Trading in Palawan;

WHEREAS, during the 194th PCSD meeting the technical support Staff of the Council recommended to the PCSD for appropriate action Fifteen (15) duly evaluated projects for issuance of SEP Clearance and PCSD Accreditation, respectively, as presented in Annex "A";

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion, duly seconded;

The Council **RESOLVED** as it is hereby **RESOLVED** to approve the issuance of SEP Clearance/Accreditation for the aforementioned projects as shown in Annex "A" hereof and made integral part of this resolution;

RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish copies of the Resolution the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, PENRO, Environmental Management Bureau – DENR, League of Municipalities, League of Barangays and all concerned LGUs and agencies for their information and appropriate action.
