**PCSD RESOLUTION NO. 05-264**

**RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FEES PRESCRIBED UNDER SECTION 4 OF THE "GUIDELINES ON VISITOR MANAGEMENT FOR THE CALAUIT GAME PRESERVE AND WILDLIFE SANCTUARY"**

**WHEREAS**, R.A. 7611, otherwise known as the Strategic Environmental Plan provides that it shall serve as the framework to guide the government agencies concerned in the formulation of plans, programs and projects affecting the environment and natural resources of Palawan;

**WHEREAS**, Section of R.A. 7611 provides that the governance, implementation and policy direction of the SEP shall be exercised by the Palawan Council For Sustainable Development (PCSD), under the Office of the President;

**WHEREAS**, Section 19 of R.A. 7611 states that the Council is vested with power to "arrange, negotiable for, and accept donations, grants, gifts, and other funding from domestic and foreign sources to carry out the activities and purposes of the SEP;

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Justice Opinion No. 90 dated 20 June 1995 that the PCSD "possesses complete administrative and management authority over protected areas in Palawan";

**WHEREAS**, effective 01 January 1995, through a Memorandum of Agreement between the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) and the PCSD, the management and implementation of the Calauit Sanctuary shall be under the PCSD;

**WHEREAS**, through PCSD Resolution No. 95-83, the proposed "Guidelines on Visitor Management and Establishment of Trust Fund for the Calauit Game Preserve and wildlife Sanctuary" was approved on March 17, 1995;

**WHEREAS**, in lieu of the steady and dramatic rise in the prices of various commodities indispensable for the daily operations of the Caluit Game Preserve and Wildlife Sanctuary, it is deemed necessary that the current Park rates must adapt to these changes;

**NOW THEREFORE**, upon motion by Exec. Dir. Nelson P. Devanadera duly seconded, be it **RESOLVED** as it is hereby **RESOLVED** that the Council approves, as it hereby approves, that the Fees provided for under Section 4 of the "Guidelines on Visitor Management and Establishment of Trust Fund for the Calauit Game Preserve and Wildlife Sanctuary", referred to as the Calauit Guidelines, be amended to adapt to the present economic changes;

**RESOLVED FURTHER**, that said Section 4 of the Caluit Guidelines shall, hereinafter, read as follows:

**Section 4. Fees.** The following, hereinafter classified, are the entrance, other fees, and exemptions to be paid for by all visitors upon approval of application, and collected in the offices specified in section 1(i);

**A. ENTRANCE FEE**

1. Foreigners (Tourist)  
Adult -----P 350.00  
Children (below 12 y/o) -----P 250.00
2. Filipino/Local  
Adult -----P 250.00

- Children (7 to 12 y/o) -----P 100.00
- 3. Filipino Government Officials -----P 150.00  
(including Lakbay-Aral)
- 4. Filipino (Non-Government Organization) -----P 150.00
- 5. Educational Tours prepared by school  
Staff from Calamian Area and students  
Conducting practicum, thesis Work, etc. -----P 50.00
- 6. Educational Tours, Practicum,  
Thesis Work, etc. from other place -----P 100.00
- 7. Senior Citizens & Handicap ----- Free

**B. FILMING FEE**

- 1. Filipino -----P 5,000.00/day
- 2. Foreigner -----P 10,000.00/day

**C. LODGING FEE**

Filipino and/or Foreigner -----P 200.00/Head/

Day Overnight

**D. CAMPING FEE (Inclusive of Guide Service)**

Filipino and/or Foreigner -----P 350.00 per group  
Per night maximum  
Of 7 pax plus 50.00  
per pax in excess

**E. TRUCK SERVICE FEE**

- 1. Guests from Club Paradise ----- P 1,500.00/ group  
tour at a maximum  
of 10 pax plus  
150.00/pax in  
excess of the  
maximum
- 2. Guests from other Places -----P 1,000.00/group  
at a maximum
