PCSD RESOLUTION No. 10-402

“APPROVING THE PROPOSED AMENDMENT OF PCSD ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 05” (REVISED GUIDELINES FOR THE ACCREDITATION, REGULATION, AND MONITORING OF LIVE FISH CATCHING, CULTURE, TRANSPORT AND TRADING IN PALAWAN, PROVIDING THEREFOR THE GUIDELINES FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF A QUOTA SYSTEM (QS) FOR LIVE REEF FOOD FISH TO BE TRANSPORTED OUT OF PALAWAN).

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WHEREAS, R.A. 7611, otherwise known as the Strategic Environmental Plan (SEP) for Palawan, took effect on 19 June 1992, Section 6 of which provides that the SEP shall serve as the framework to guide the government agencies concerned in the formulation of plans, programs and projects affecting the environment and natural resources of Palawan pursuant to the declared policy of the State to protect, develop and conserve its natural resources towards which, it shall assist and support the implementation of plans, programs and projects formulated to preserve and enhance the environment, and at the same time pursue the socioeconomic development goals of the country;

WHEREAS, pursuant to paragraph (8), Section 19, Chapter V of Republic Act No. 7611, the PCSD is vested with the power to adopt, amend and rescind such rules and regulations and impose penalties for the effective implementation of the provisions of Strategic Environmental Plan for Palawan and that, in accordance therewith, the Council passed PCSD Admin. Order No. 00-05 providing for the administrative penalties of fines and forfeitures for violations of its provisions;

WHEREAS, PCSD Administrative Order No. 00-05 has been in force and effect for more than ten (10) years now and there is a need to keep its provisions in tune with the constantly changing circumstances and thus include within its purview, among others, the growing practice and/or trade of commercial or private storage of live fish;

WHEREAS, there is a need to include in the said Administrative Order No. 00-05 sufficient and well-defined standards to serve as guidelines in the imposition of administrative penalties consistent with the requirements of the Constitution that no excessive fines and penalties be imposed;

WHEREAS, in view of the challenges facing the live fish industry, there is a need to revise the Guidelines For The Accreditation, Regulation, And Monitoring Of Live Fish Catching, Culture, Trading and Transport In Palawan, by providing therefor the guidelines for the implementation of a quota system (QS) for live reef food fish to be transported out of Palawan;

WHEREFORE, upon motion of Atty. Grizelda Mayo Anda, duly seconded, the Council **RESOLVES** as it is hereby **RESOLVED**, to approve the proposed amendments of PCSD Administrative Order No. 00-05 to be known as the **“Revised Guidelines for the Accreditation, Regulation, and Monitoring of Live Fish Catching, Culture, Trading and Transport in Palawan, Providing Therefor the Guidelines for the Implementation of a Quota System (QS) for Live Reef Food Fish to be Transported Out of Palawan”**, copy of which is hereto attached marked as Annex “A” and made integral part of this resolution;

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT, the same be indorsed to the Provincial Government for appropriate action.

APPROVED and ADOPTED this 25th day of March 2010 in Puerto Princesa City.
