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### RESOLUTION NO. 18-651

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**“APPROVING THE TEN-YEAR CITY ECOLOGICAL SOLID  
WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN 2018-2027 OF THE CITY  
GOVERNMENT OF PUERTO PRINCESA”**

**WHEREAS**, on June 19, 1992, Republic Act No. 7611, otherwise known as the Strategic Environmental Plan (SEP) for Palawan Act, was enacted declaring the policy to protect, develop and conserve its natural resources. It shall support and promote the sustainable development goals for the province through proper conservation, utilization and development of natural resources to provide optimum yields on a continuing basis;

**WHEREAS**, Section 6 of the same law provides that the SEP shall serve as the framework to guide the government agencies concerned in the formulation and implementation of plans, programs and projects affecting the environment and natural resources of Palawan;

*Vision:* Palawan, an innovative and dynamic global center of sustainable development

*Mission:* PCSDS as the driver of environmental conservation and inclusive development in Palawan, a biosphere reserve and science-for-sustainability site, guided by the Strategic Environmental Plan

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**WHEREAS**, Section 11 of the Republic Act No. 9003, otherwise known as the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000, provides that a Provincial Solid Waste Management Board shall be established in every province and that in the Province of Palawan, the Board shall be chaired by the chairman of the Palawan Council for Sustainable Development, pursuant to Republic Act No. 7611;

**WHEREAS**, Section 16 of the same law provides that the province, city or municipality, through its local solid waste management boards, shall prepare its respective 10-year solid waste management plans consistent with the National Solid Waste Management Framework;

**WHEREAS**, the same law further states that all local government solid waste management plans shall be subjected to the approval of the National Solid Waste Commission; Provided, that in the Province of Palawan, the local government solid waste management plan shall be approved by the Palawan Council for Sustainable Development, pursuant to R.A. No. 7611;

**WHEREAS**, after a joint technical evaluation and review conducted by the PCSDS and National Solid Waste Management Commission Secretariat last March 2018 and subsequent review and refinement done by the PCSDS, the above-mentioned Plan was presented to the PCSD for approval;

**WHEREAS**, after exhaustive deliberation and discussion on the subject Plan, the Council recommended that the waste management program should consider creating the culture of reduce, reuse and recycle and include these concepts in the SWM plan with an objective to educate the people by changing mind sets for sustainability, continuity and consistency;

**WHEREAS**, the Council likewise proposed that the wastes generated may be utilized by turning compost materials for the farm inputs as counterpart of the LGU for the agricultural sector to address low level soil fertility, improve production and provide decent income to farmers;

**WHEREFORE**, in consideration of the foregoing premises and upon motion duly seconded, the Council resolves as it is hereby **RESOLVED**, approving the Ten-Year Municipal Ecological Solid Waste Management Plan 2018-2027 of the City Government of Puerto Princesa;


