PCSD RESOLUTION NO. 93-27

**RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE GUIDELINES ON
TOURISM-ORIENTED ESTABLISHMENTS IN THE
PROVINCE OF PALAWAN**

Whereas, R.A. 7611, otherwise known as the Strategic Environmental Plan (SEP) for Palawan Act, took effect on June 19, 1992 and Section 16 of the said Act provides that the governance, implementation and policy direction of the SEP shall be exercised by the Palawan Council for Sustainable Development (PCSD);


Whereas, the same section requires that all local governments in Palawan and the concerned national and regional government agencies operating therein shall coordinate and align their projects and corresponding budgets with the projects, programs and policies of the SEP as administered and implemented by the aforementioned administrative machinery, the PCSD;

Whereas, Section 12 of the same Act provides for the management of resources outside the Environmental Critical Areas Network (ECAN) and shall include coastal resources, resources of the catchment areas, timber and mines, development in the lowlands and settlement areas. It shall also provide for tourism planning.

Whereas, there is a need to guide the Local Government Units (LGUs) in the exercise of the devolved regulatory functions from the Department of Tourism as mandated in the Republic Act 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of the Philippines;

NOW THEREFORE, on unanimous motion, the Palawan Council for Sustainable Development hereby resolves to express its gratitude and appreciation to the Honorable Secretary, Angel C. Alcala for having given his time and shared his opinions to the Council.
