In view of the two (2) failed public biddings, the Palawan Council for Sustainable Development Staff (PCSDS) Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) invites interested bidders to participate in the negotiation for the project, PR. No. 19-10-007 (C): Supply and Delivery of Motor Vehicles for Palawan Council for Sustainable Development Staff (FY 2020)," in accordance with Section 53.1 of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (R.A.) No. 9184, otherwise known as the Government Procurement Reform Act;
- 2. The PCSDS intends to apply the sum of **Eight hundred eighty thousand pesos (Php 880,000.00) pesos** being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for the project under FY 2020. The funding source is through the authorized appropriations under the National Expenditure Program (NEP) for the succeeding year Single Year (FY 2020). The required specification of the subject procurement is listed in the Annex attached hereto;

The PCSDS-BAC will hold a negotiation conference with all interested bidders on January 21, 2020, 10:00 in the morning at the PCSD Building, Sports Complex Road, Barangay Santa Monica, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan. Submission of "Best Offer/Proposal" shall immediately follow at 10:30 AM on the same date.
- 4. The Eligibility Documents, Technical Proposal and Best and Final Offer stated in the checklist shall be submitted in one (1) original and two (2) duplicate copies;
- 5. Interested bidders may obtain further information from the PCSDS-BAC Secretariat at the address given below during office hours from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM;
- 6. The PCSDS reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance with Section 41 of R.A. No. 9184 and its IRR, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.

Green Specifications: (applicable to all bid items listed above)

- The supplier shall ensure that the vehicle meets the EURO IV Standard.
- The supplier shall give information about the emissions of the vehicles by presenting the technical sheets of the vehicle.
- The supplier shall provide a guarantee for the vehicle for a period of at least 3 years or 100,000 km, whichever comes first. The offer of the bidder has to include the required guarantee/warranty.
- The supplier shall demonstrate guarantee the availability of parts for the specific vehicle model for at least 7 years from the time production of the particular model ceases. Bidder must provide a written guarantee that the criterion concerning the availability of parts will be met.
