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PCSD RESOLUTION NO. 19-679

“APPROVING THE TEN-YEAR MUNICIPAL ECOLOGICAL SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN 2018-2028 OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF SAN VICENTE”

WHEREAS, on June 19, 1992, Republic Act No. 7611, otherwise known as the Strategic Environmental Plan (SEP) for Palawan Act was enacted, declaring the policy to protect, develop and conserve its natural resources. It shall support and promote the sustainable development goals for the province through proper conservation, utilization and development of natural resources to provide optimum yields on a continuing basis;

Vision: Palawan, an innovative and dynamic global center of sustainable development
Mission: PCSDS as the driver of environmental conservation and inclusive development in Palawan,
a biosphere reserve and science-for-sustainability site, guided by the Strategic Environmental Plan

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WHEREAS, Section 6 of the same law provides that the SEP shall serve as the framework to guide the government agencies concerned in the formulation and implementation of plans, programs and projects affecting the environment and natural resources of Palawan; all local governments in Palawan and the concerned national and regional government agencies operating therein shall coordinate and align their projects and the corresponding budgets with the project, programs and policies of the SEP;

WHEREAS, Section 16 of RA 7611 provides that the governance, implementation and policy direction of the Strategic Environmental Plan for Palawan Act shall be exercised by the Palawan Council for Sustainable Development;

WHEREAS, Section 11 of the Republic Act No. 9003 otherwise known as the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000 provides that a Provincial Solid Waste Management Board shall be established in every province and that in the Province of Palawan the Board shall be chaired by the chairman of the Palawan Council for Sustainable Development, pursuant to Republic Act No. 7611;

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the RA 9003 provides that the province, city or municipality, through its local solid waste management boards, shall prepare its respective 10-year solid waste management plans consistent with the National Solid Waste Management Framework;

WHEREAS, the same law further states that all local government solid waste management plans shall be subject to the approval of the National Solid Waste Commission (NSWMC); Provided, that in the Province of Palawan, the local government solid waste management plan shall be approved by the Palawan Council for Sustainable Development, pursuant to R.A. No. 7611;

WHEREAS, on June 13, 2019, the Municipal government of San Vicente submitted to the PCSDS their revised “Ten-Year Municipal Ecological Solid Waste Management Plan 2018-2028;

WHEREAS, after evaluation and review by the PCSDS on August 2019, the said plan was recommended for final review and approval by the PCSD;

WHEREAS, in today’s meeting, after exhaustive deliberation and discussion, the PCSD resolved to adopt the recommendation of the PCSDS and approve the said plan, subject to the condition that the recommendation and comments indicated in the PCSDS evaluation sheet for the San Vicente ESWM Plan be incorporated and/or taken into consideration in the plan;

WHEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing premises and on motion duly seconded, the Council resolves to approve, as it is hereby APPROVED the revised “Ten-Year

Municipal Ecological Solid Waste Management Plan 2018-2028 of the Municipal Government of San Vicente,” subject to the condition that the recommendation and comments of the PCSDS be incorporated and/or taken into consideration in the plan;

RESOLVED FINALLY, that copies of this Resolution be furnished the LGU of San Vicente, the Provincial Government – Environment and Natural Resources Office (PG-ENRO), the National Solid Waste Management Commission and all other concerned parties and agencies for their information, guidance and reference.

RESOLVED AND ADOPTED this 12th day of September 2019 at Puerto Princesa City.
